Preparation of new electoral roll... Every six years each parish is required to prepare a new electoral roll. The last was completed in 2013, meaning that in this year, 2019, a new electoral roll is required. Everyone will need to re-apply to be put on the electoral roll. It underpins the whole structure of synodical government in the Church. It contains the names and addresses of everyone who can vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), to be held on Sunday 7th April at 1130.

There are strict time requirements. Notices publicising the renewal exercise will go up at the beginning of next month. The revision period itself, when enrolment forms will be available for completion, will run from 10th to 25th March.
