Preparation of new electoral roll... Every six years each parish is required to prepare a new electoral roll. The last was completed in 2013, meaning that in this year, 2019, a new electoral roll is required. Everyone will need to re-apply to be put on the electoral roll. The Church electoral roll underpins the whole structure of synodical government in the Church. It contains the names and addresses of everyone who can vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) which will be held on Sunday 7th April at 1130.

There are strict time requirements. There are notices up publicising the renewal exercise. The revision period itself, when enrolment forms will be available for completion, will run from 10th to 25th March.
